Picked up at your home/specified pickup point

Organic waste 

In the waste bin with the brown lid

Yes please!

- Peels from fruits and vegetables
- Coffee grounds (also with filter)
- Tea bags
- Eggshell
- Nutshell
- Fish bones and small meat bones
- Paper towels used to wipe up food spills
- Seafood leftovers
- Other food leftovers



No please!

- Diapers, sanitary pads, and tampons
- Food with packaging
- Large meat bones
- Animal/slaughter waste
- Garden waste
- Snuff and chewing gum
- Large amounts of liquid waste

Glass and metal packaging 

In the waste bin with the red lid

Yes please!

- Wine, soft drink and cooking oil bottles
- Metal corcs and lids
- Jars (food, spices, jam, babyfood etc...)
- Empty perfume bottles and medicine jars
- Tins and tubes
- Aluminium foil and forms



No please!

- Drinking glasses, crystal and ovenproof dishes
- Pots and pans, kitchen utensils of metal
- Lightbulbs/fluorescent light tubes
- Spray cans
- Mirrors, fireplace glass and glass from windows
- Glass and metal that is not packaging
- Porcelain and pottery

Cardboard and paper 

In the waste bin with the blue lid

Yes please!

- Cardboard boxes and corrugated cardboard
- Cardboard cups and plates marked with the sorting sign
- Cardboard wine box
- Softcover books
- Magazines, newsprint and advertising
- Paper, writing paper etc...
- Cardboard used for food or drinks



No please!

- Paper cup and plates not marked with the sorting sign
- Napkins
- Shiny/colored Christmas wrapping
- Receipts
- Wet or dirty cardboard and paper
- Shredded paper

Non-recyclable waste 

In the waste bin with the green/black lid

Yes please!

- Mixed packaging (e.g. crisp bag with foil inside)
- Cat litter and dog bags
- Ash and dust (wrapped)
- Plastic products
- Broken drinking glass
- Diapers, sanitary pads, and tampons
- Wood sacks and straps
- Shredded paper

No please!

- Battery and spray cans 
- Electrical products 
- Chemicals, cleaning liquids, paint, nail polish etc....
- Dead animals/waste from hunting/slaughter
- Waste that can be recycled

Plastic packaging 

In the Nomil bag for plastic packaging

Yes please!

- Plastic bottles and cans (e.g. shampoo bottles)
- Plastic foil
- Plastic bags, bread bags and shopping bags
- Plastic cups and boxes
- Sushi trays, similar trays
- Plastic packaging
- Snuff boxes (empty)
- Plastic deodorant (empty)
- Cosmetic tubes etc..



No please!

- Dirty plastic packaging
- Plastic products that are not packaging (e.g. toothbrushes)
- Wood sacks and straps
- Styrofoam
- Q-tips
- Agricultural plastic
- CD/DVD covers

Must be delivered to a recycling station

At our recycling stations, can household and cabin subscribers deliver almost all types of waste, including:

- **Hazardous waste:** batteries, fluorescent light tubes, spray cans, paint, varnish, glue, asbestos.
- **Garden waste:** grass, roots and branches. NOTE! Non-native species must be wrapped and disposed of in the residual waste.
- **Electrical waste:** anything that runs on electricity or batteries (vacuum cleaners, PCs, flashing shoes etc....).
- **Metal and scrap metal:** Things made of metal, which are not packaging. Anything that is made of a lot of metal can be delivered as metal, e.g. an armchair with a metal core, even if it is also made of other materials.
- Large amounts of residual waste, cardboard, plastic packaging that you can't fit in the bin at home.
- We only accept tires in Eidsmona (Sandane).
